
Notes from the Editor

John started with a segmented vase blank that had been glued up earlier. Using a band saw, John cut strips of differently coloured wood and glued them together. He then accurately marked and drilled a hole down the centre. Then John cut the multi coloured blank into thin slices. Using the centre hole, each slice was fed

onto a dowel, rotated a few degrees and glued in place. This produced a spiral pattern. He added a left over segmented piece from a previous

project and added a solid top and bottom. The blank (see picture) wasn't much to look at, but once turned, it looked amazing.

John's second project was a segmented platter. Similar construction to the first project, but with larger segments

John's last project was a lidded box. To ensure the fit of the lid doesn't change over time, John always part turns the box, leaving enough material to finish turning after all wood movement, due to stress relief, has ended.
